General Education Requirements

Humanities and/or Fine Arts (9 hours)

Students must enroll in approved humanities courses to meet this requirement.

Behavioral and Social Science (9 hours)

American History (HIST 1100 or 1200 or see See MU General Education information (<http://generaleducation.missouri.edu/requirements/>) for other courses) (3 hours) -or-

American Government (POL SC 1100 or 1700) (3 hours)

General Psychology (PSYCH 1000) (3 hours)

Developmental Psychology (PSYCH 2410) (3 hours)
